

2nd Grade Learning Activities

Week 3

ELA

Reading- Compare/Contrast how you celebrated Easter this year with how you celebrated Easter last year. What things are the same, different?

Reading- Make a list of compound words around your house (Ex. cupcake, firefly, pancake)

Writing- Write a personal narrative story about what you and your family have done at home so far during this quarantine. Remember to use capital letters and punctuation!

Math

Number Sense- Using a deck of cards or an adult, gather 3 numbers. Write your 3-digit number in words, expanded form, and a base ten numeral drawing. (Ex. 234- two hundred thirty four, $200+30+4$)

Graphing- Create a graph to show 3 or more items. Remember to label each side of the graph (axis), show your items you graphed (categories), and have a title. You could use plates, bowls, cups or forks, knives, spoons, anything with 3 or more categories!

Number Sense- Place value scavenger hunt. Either print (page 4-6) or duplicate this for students to “hunt” for numbers in magazines, newspapers, or books.

Social Studies- Write (or type) 1 thank you note/letter to send to a local business or hospital. Be sure to write your return address on the envelope! You can mail this using the addresses on the next page, email this to your teacher to send, or drop off during the school lunch pick-up lines for the office to send. (You’re welcome to write more than 1 letter if you’d like)

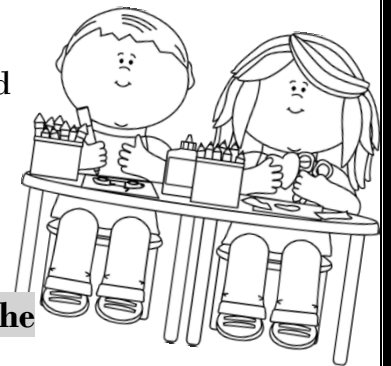
Reading Bingo (pg. 3)
