ELA

Reading- Tuesday, May 5th is Cinco De Mayo! This is a day that celebrates the Mexican Army's victory over the French Empire. Today, we want you to celebrate with a Cinco De Mayo Celebration!

- Find a recipe with a Mexican style dish. Have an adult help you follow the step-by-step directions to complete the recipe, share with your family.
- Pretend you were going to throw a party to celebrate Cinco De Mayo! Create an invitation! Be sure to list the time of your party, the address of your house where the party is located, and list the events that will take place at your party! You could play games, eat food, or plan a craft! 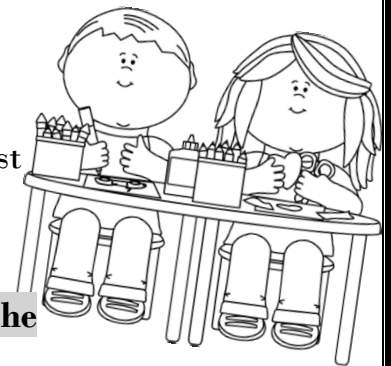

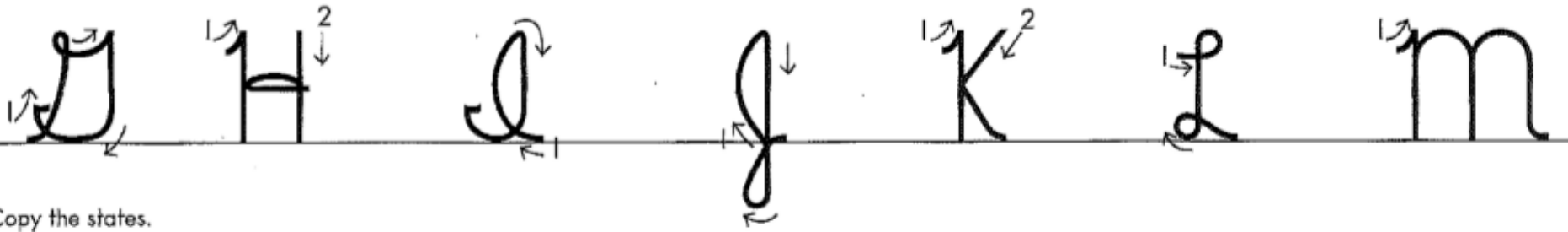
